Talking to Henning Wergen, Chair of the ECA 2019 Program Committee

1. Are you satisfied with the number and the quality of submitted abstracts?

We are more than satisfied. With 84 submissions representing authors from 27 countries the Call for Papers was very well received by the actuarial community. Most proposals – making a total of 82 % - were handed in by European actuaries, which is also represented in the actual congress program. The quality of the submitted presentations was remarkably high so that we could compile a congress program from a very large number of suitable submissions. I want to thank the whole Program Committee for their work in the last weeks. From setting up the Call for Papers, over reviewing the submissions up to the selection of suitable presentations for the final program. The results can be found on the website.

2. Are there topics that have been taken up particularly often?

We have received a large number of submissions focusing on actuarial data science. Not only though – the congress program also represents a wide variety of other actuarial topics, especially including several talks that go beyond the topics outlined in the Call for Papers.

3. Who is the ECA 2019 aimed at?

The ECA 2019 is particularly aimed at practitioners from Europe who are interested in getting new perspectives and thinking outside the box.

Gala Event

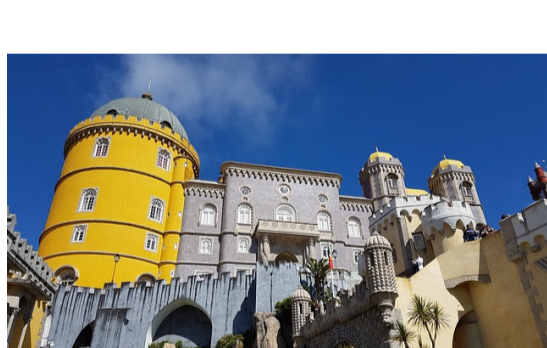
